GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT PRICES, PLANTS AND ORDERING

4 inch pots or smaller: \$3.00 (10 or more \$2.75)

4.5 inch pots or larger: \$3.50 (10 or more \$3.00)

Herbs: \$2.75

Deliveries can be made when 8 or more plants are ordered. The delivery sites will be general locations within a 25 mile radius of the business address for an additional cost of \$5. Customers may also make arrangements to pick up their orders at the business.

NOTE: An alternative location for picking up orders on Saturday during the months of May thru June 3rd is the Canby Saturday Market. This would need to be prearranged to ensure that all the plants ordered would be there.
